A Dress Code Committee (made up of students, parents, teachers and administrators), has decided that, as of the 2003/04 school year, students will have to dress according to the "UB4" policy.

The wearing of hats is **NOT** permitted inside the school.

* **ALSO** (as in our present policy) no **OFFENSIVE MATERIAL, SEXIST OR RACIST SLOGANS, ALCOHOL OR DRUGS RELATED LOGOS.**

Clothing that exposes any of these areas should not be worn. This means clothing like 'beaters', low-riding pants, or high-cut shirts will not be permitted. If you choose to wear any clothing that does not cover your navel, your back, bottom or breasts (any cleavage), you will have to cover-up (if needed we can supply a stylish, yet modest SOSS shirt), or be sent home to change. Also, if you feel the urge to wear your boxers or other underwear above your waistline, you will have to keep your pants up there with them.

Our school is a place of business, and as such beach attire is not appropriate. For this reason, we want to promote the wearing of clothing that is tasteful and inoffensive to others. This will also help create a safe, harassment-free environment in our school.
