- To date \$2997.08 has been spent, with \$76, 858.92 remaining. Spending has been on food for meetings, mileage, and honorariums.
- Proposal mentioned as part of full budget discussion to transfer \$3,600.00 for Brad's time in his role as Secretariat from IEC budget to add to targeted funding.
- 5. Language in Schools and Recruitment/Retainment Update Naryn Searcy
  - Naryn met with USIB and LSIB to revise posting, and with OIB to revise posting
  - Language changes/revisions to the postings have been implemented
  - Any posting with new and update language with be shared with Education Coordinators before it is posted publicly
- 6. <u>Honorary Chair Update-</u> Naryn Searcy
  - Naryn and Brad reached out to Leona Prince (Assistant Superintendent of Indigenous Education, Ministry of Education and Child Care) for more details about what the expectations and time commitment would be for an honorary IEC Chair
  - From Leona:
    - Time commitment is at least one meeting in the lower mainland per year and then a few online meeting obligations
    - o It has never been a large time commitment
    - Meetings in lower mainland are the IEC chair meetings and JCAM (Jointly Convened Annual Meeting between FNESC and the Ministry of Education and Child Care).
    - Main responsibility of the honorary chair would be to attend provincial meetings, speak on behalf of the IEC and report back.
