##### 5. Looking Ahead:

- How has this course influenced your career goals in the trades?
- What are your next steps in your trade journey?

- Clear and thoughtful response to the guiding questions.
- Use of specific examples or experiences to support your ideas.
- Logical organization, proper grammar, and spelling.
- A strong conclusion that summarizes your key takeaways.
