Reporting is Changing in Okanagan Similkameen Public Schools

B.C.'s New Curriculum and Reporting Procedures are based on a competency-driven model of "Know-Do-Understand" that will support students to acquire the skills they need. A collection of evidence that captures student progress in their learning will be used.

The goal of reporting is to identify:

- student learning over time,
- student strengths,
- areas for improvement,
- ways to support student growth.

What to Expect

Communications will occur a <u>minimum</u> of 5 times within a school year.

- 2 points of progress (digital or paper) during the school year.
- A minimum of 2 communications that are less formal (student-led conferences, phone calls, parent-teacher conferences).
- > 1 final summative written report card at the end of the year.

Communication about student learning can happen in a variety of ways including:

- > in person,
- > electronically,
- sharing student work samples.

Communication will share personalized information on curricular and core competency development.

A proficiency scale, along with descriptive feedback, will be used in K-9, <u>rather than letter</u> grades.

This scale will reflect the student's progress in relation to grade level expectations as detailed below.

Frequently Asked Questions

When can I expect information regarding my child's learning?

✓ Communication is intended to be timely and responsive, not necessarily at designated times of the year. Families will receive information a minimum of 5 time per year.

Can I request an update regarding my child's learning?

✓ Yes, as in previous years, families are encouraged to contact their child's teacher(s) at any time in the school year.

Can you explain the proficiency scale in further detail?

- ✓ **Emerging** Beginning to demonstrate basic knowledge and/or understanding
 - Completes work with ongoing support
- ✓ **Developing** Demonstrates some knowledge/understanding
 - Completes work with some support
- \checkmark **Proficient** Demonstrates good knowledge and understanding
 - Completes work independently
- Extending Demonstrates knowledge/understanding above and beyond the learning standards
 - Completes work independently
 - Transfers knowledge/understanding to other areas
