



What is PEBT?

Your guide to understanding your PEBT benefits

PEBT supports member well-being through employee health and disability benefits designed for the public education sector.

PEBT is different from an insurance company

PEBT is not-for-profit and member-focused. It oversees the benefit plans and works with trusted organizations—including Desjardins, Pacific Blue Cross, Blue Cross Life and AIG—to administer benefits on PEBT's behalf. PEBT partners with organizations that share its commitment to members.

Who is this for?

Unionized support staff in BC public schools. Benefit details can vary by school district and employee group. Check out pebt.ca and click on My Benefits to learn about yours.



Why know your benefits?

Understanding your benefits before you need them can reduce stress and help you know where to go and what questions to ask.

Member checklist

Start here:

- ✓ **Visit** pebt.ca and find your school district/union local under My Benefits.
- ✓ **Enroll** in the benefits plan within the timelines and avoid becoming a late applicant.
- ✓ **Register** for the PBC member portal, if applicable.

When you need support:

- ✓ **Find** forms, FAQs, and videos about your benefits.
- ✓ **Watch** the What To Expect videos for JEIS and LTD to understand what happens if you are away from work due to illness or injury.
- ✓ **Contact** your school district benefits administrator for information specific to you.
